

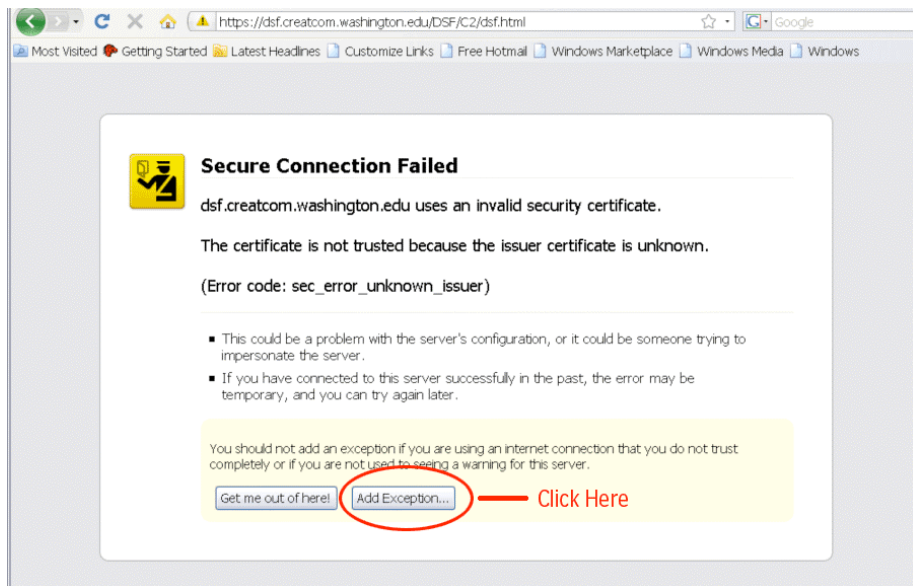
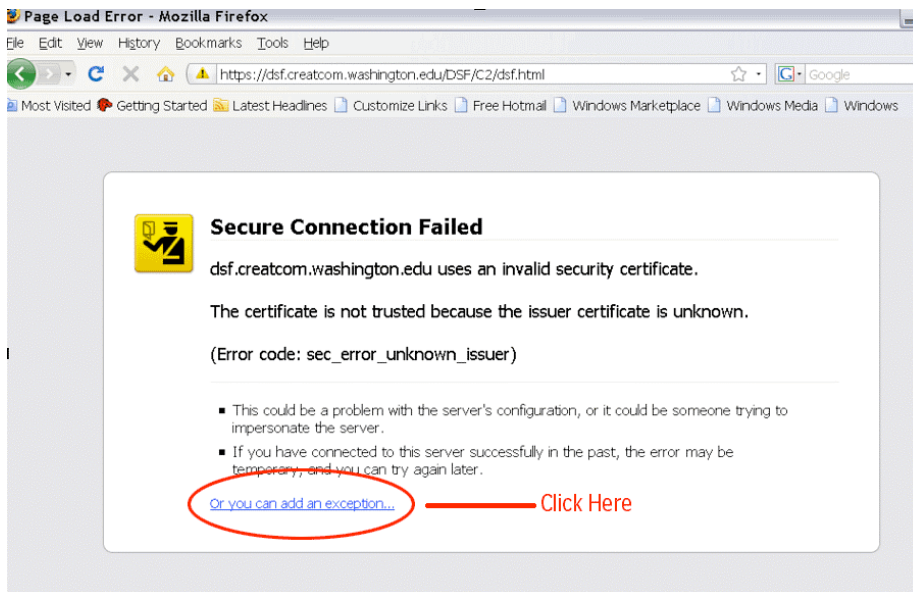
Getting a Certificate from UW Certificate Authority
