

New webcast format for MRAM

You can access the MRAM meeting live, using your web browser to view and hear the meeting content. The link will be available on the [MRAM website](#) before each meeting. This technical functionality is currently used for the Faculty Brown Bag series with great success.

Easy steps:

Go to the [MRAM webpage](#), click on "[MRAM Meetings in 2012](#)" and then click on the specific meeting date.

The meeting page will have a link to the webcast. <http://uofw.adobeconnect.com/mram/>

- The URL may be different for each meeting, so use the MRAM website when logging on
- Sign in as a **guest** (no password is needed)
- You will be asked to sign in (fill in the blank); it would be helpful if you entered your full name and if there are others in your party (i.e. Jane Smith +2, Psychology)
- Webcast interface will open to display the PowerPoint, show the speaker in the top left corner of your monitor and a chat feature in the bottom left for questions
- Sound will come from the website – no need to dial in on your phone!
- If you have a question, just use the chat feature & type it in, and the moderator will ask the question on your behalf.

Whenever possible, we ask that units view the meeting from a single conference room, using a single login (e.g., Jane Smith, Chemistry, +2), as our Adobe license limits us to 100 logins per meeting.

The "live" meeting has been moved to a much smaller room for the rest of 2012. You may join us in the UW Tower Visitor's Dining Room located on the Mezzanine Level.

After [each](#) meeting an archive of the webcast will be posted to the MRAM website, where you can view it at any time.
