

Announcing Mandatory Chemical Safety Training for

Globally Harmonized System (GHS)

Who:

- UW personnel who work with hazardous chemicals or have a reasonably anticipated potential for exposure to hazardous chemicals at the UW are required to complete one-time online or in-person classroom training
- UWMC, HMC and Facilities Services personnel <u>do not</u> need the EH&S training because customized GHS training will be provided by their organizations
- This training is <u>not</u> required for consumer use of chemical products (e.g., infrequent use of office cleaning products, toner, white out, etc.)

What:

- One-time training
- Online (25 min.) OR in-person (40 min.)

- Class title: GHS-Globally Harmonized System (Hazcom)
- Training must be completed by <u>June 1, 2014</u>

- Safety and Compliance: Federal and WA State Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), have adopted the globally harmonized system (GHS) for chemical hazard communication and labeling to enhance safety
- Compliance with WA State OSHA (Labor & Industries) rules for <u>Hazard</u>
 <u>Communication</u>, <u>Globally Harmonized System (GHS)</u> and <u>Hazardous Chemicals in</u>
 Laboratories
