


## COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Chapter 38.34 of the Revised Code of Washington and other provisions of the law, The City of Kennewick, a political subdivision of the State of Washington and the University of Washington, an agency of the State of Washington hereby agree to cooperative purchasing upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Both parties agree to extend to the other the benefits of contracts entered into for the purchase or supplies, material and equipment in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.
2. Notwithstanding the date of execution of this Agreement, it shall be effective beginning October 1, 2008 and shall continue in effect until terminated by one part or the other. Either party may terminate this Agreement by written notice to the other, effective immediately upon receipt of such notice or three days after the date thereof, whichever occurs later.
3. Both parties agree that all purchases made from contracts will be made only for the direct use of the political subdivision or agency and will not be made on behalf of other jurisdictions. Each party takes sole responsibility for payment of goods and services it purchases under the contracts.
4. Each party shall comply in all respects with local and state laws and regulations regarding public bidding applicable to it, and further shall indicate on notices to bidders that contracts shall be made available to the other party or parties as the case may be.
5. Each party agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the other regarding allegations that such party has not complied with such laws and regulations.
