




Non-PO Invoice Enhancements "Good news! eProcurement Non-PO Invoice has made some system enhancements to improve the overall user experience. The following changes are now in effect."



Enhancements for Department Use

A Title field added which holds 128 characters. This will help departments label each Non-PO (i.e. by Lab name for easy identification of who should approve the Non-PO Invoice or Purchase Path number) Budget and account (object) codes now show on the summary screen and the

- Enhancements/Fixes for System Use Remit-to Address now defaults to blank. This requires departments choose
- the Remit-To Address as listed on the invoice to ensure payments are delivered to the correct address for the supplier. Invoice number field now has a maximum of 15 characters, which matches PAS. This should eliminate PAS rejection delays due to invoice number is-Bug for budget number on sales tax line is now fixed.


